






Scope & Sequence: Fast ForWord Literacy Advanced

Meteor Ball 	Distinguishing a target word when presented in a series of pronounced and written words	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Language comprehension • Phonemic awareness
Lunar Leap 	Identifying the correct target word after hearing two choices	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Phonemic awareness • Sound-letter correspondence
Laser Match 	Matching pairs of words	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Phonemic awareness • Sound-letter correspondence
Galaxy Theatre 	Listening to a story, answering comprehension questions, following instructions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • English language conventions (e.g., grammar) • Vocabulary • Story comprehension and retelling
