








## Scope & Sequence: Fast ForWord Language v2

The Fast ForWord Language v2 exercises help students strengthen fundamental cognitive skills that are critical to learning across the curriculum:

- Auditory processing
- Sequencing
- Memory
- Attention

These cognitive skills are developed in the context of learning activities that simultaneously help students improve their English language arts and reading skills.

 <p>Robo-Dog</p>	Matching spoken words to pictures	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Language comprehension</li> <li>• Phonemic awareness</li> <li>• Vocabulary</li> </ul>
 <p>Ele-Bot</p>	Comprehending spoken sentences	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• English language conventions (e.g., grammar)</li> <li>• Vocabulary</li> <li>• Story comprehension and retelling</li> </ul>
 <p>Space Commander</p>	Following spoken directions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Language comprehension</li> <li>• Story comprehension and retelling</li> </ul>
