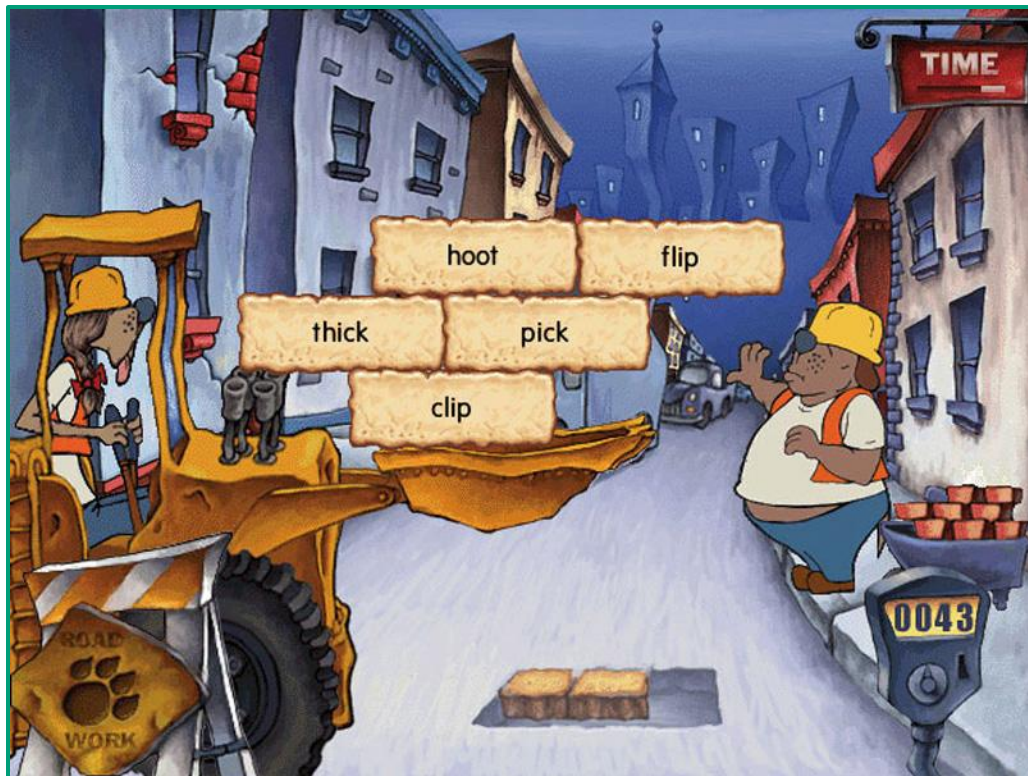
Keyboard Shortcut:


Keyboard Shortcut:

Students help the museum organize their paintings by matching the correct descriptive sentences with the pictures. Develops sentence comprehension, vocabulary development, understanding of syntax, logical reasoning, working memory.

Students help the librarian get the library back in order by putting the books back where they belong. Students read paragraphs from assigned books and answer related questions. Develops paragraph comprehension, understanding cause and effect, ability to make inferences, vocabulary development and working memory.

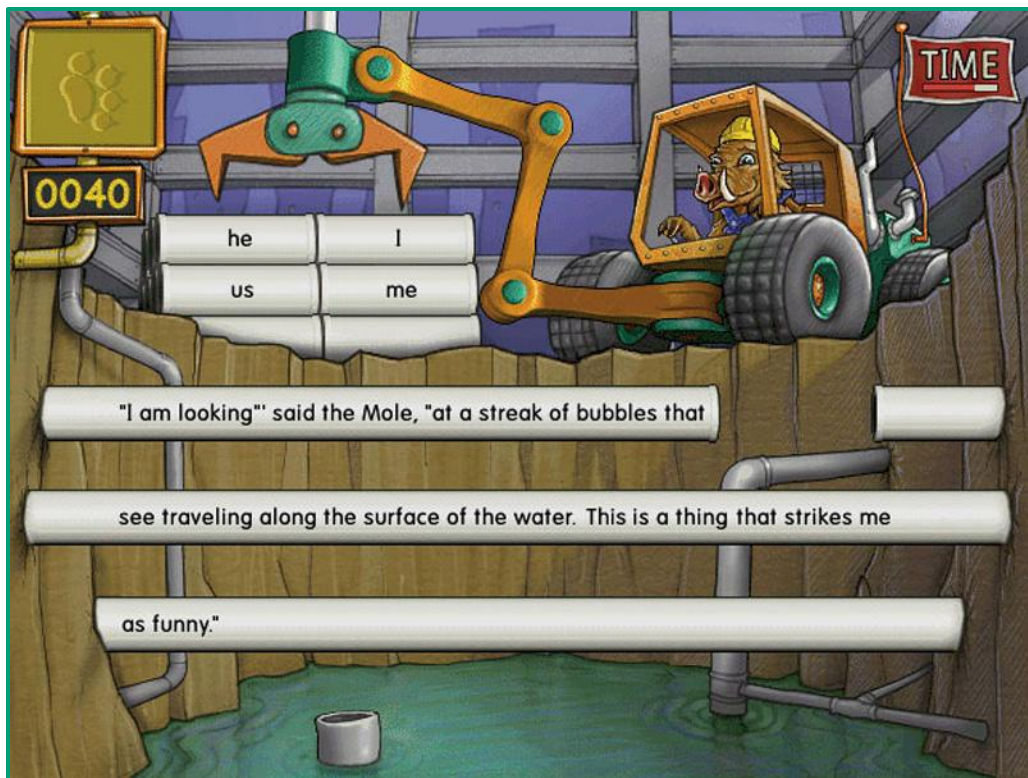
Start = Spacebar

Students help the construction crew put the piping and girders together correctly by selecting the appropriate words to fill in the missing pieces. Develops paragraph comprehension, understanding pronouns, auxiliary verbs, prefixes and suffixes, vocabulary development and making links between word choice and sentence context.
